KNOWLEDGE SUPPORT FOR ENGINEERING STUDENTS OF SCHEDULED CASTES/ SCHEDULED TRIBES COMMUNITY IN KERALA

The Scheduled Castes Development Department (SCDD), Government of Kerala, proposes to offer free knowledge and mentoring support to the engineering students from SC/ ST communities. The knowledge support will be given through special coaching and mentoring to interested students.

Following students can apply for the proposed scheme provided they are eligible to appear for the examination as per the University rules:

- Students who have dropped out in the middle of the course
- Students who have failed in examinations and have backlog of papers to clear
- Students who are studying in engineering colleges at present and need special support

In order to reach out to engineering students who need special coaching/ mentoring support, the SCDD has entrusted GIFT to identify and collect the base data of eligible students who are interested to complete their courses successfully. Eligible students may register online in the prescribed format. The online registration starts from 22 July 2017. Last date for submission of the application will be 10 August 2017.
